

# Southgate Squash and Racketball Club

## Public User/Courts

Southgate Squash and Racketball Club (SSRC) is an unincorporated association owned and managed by its members through an elected Committee. It manages all activity on the courts (as an agent of WCGT). Every member/player is obliged to consider their actions when using the facilities and do so responsibly. The rules published below are a guide and not exclusive and will be reviewed and updated on an on-going basis. 1. Public courts made by non-members/visitors can only be made directly with the SSRC by calling **07904 300288** or by email [ssrccommittee@yahoo.co.uk](mailto:ssrccommittee@yahoo.co.uk).
2. Public Courts may only be booked up to 48 hours in advance.
3. Players will pay the appropriate court fee, **in advance**, by credit/debit card or in person.
4. Once booked courts can be cancelled with **no refund**.
5. Once booked courts cannot be changed.
6. Players will complete a registration form, in full, at the time of booking.
7. Public players/visitors may only play at the SSRC a maximum of 4 times per year
8. All players will play squash or racketball according to ES published rules and regulations.
9. All persons using courts will wear non-marking shoes on court and appropriate clothing.
10. Courts are to be booked for the playing of squash or racketball only and **all other uses** must be cleared with the Committee.
11. Knock on court door and await acknowledgement before entering court.
12. Players will respect the property of SSRC and the Trust. Any abuse will result in no further bookings
13. Please report maintenance issues to the Committee via mail on the board or preferably email to: [ssrccommittee@yahoo.co.uk](mailto:ssrccommittee@yahoo.co.uk)
14. Please keep noise on the balcony and in the corridors to a minimum.
15. Children should not be on the balcony unless accompanied by an adult.
16. All complaints should be addressed to the SSRC Committee either in writing c/o The Chairman or by email to [ssrccommittee@yahoo.co.uk](mailto:ssrccommittee@yahoo.co.uk).
17. The Committees decision is final.
